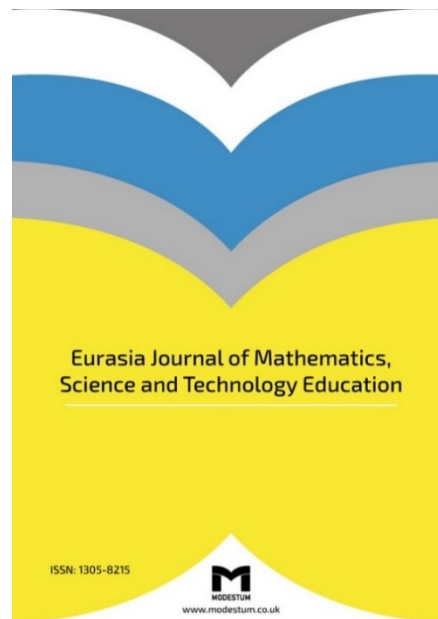

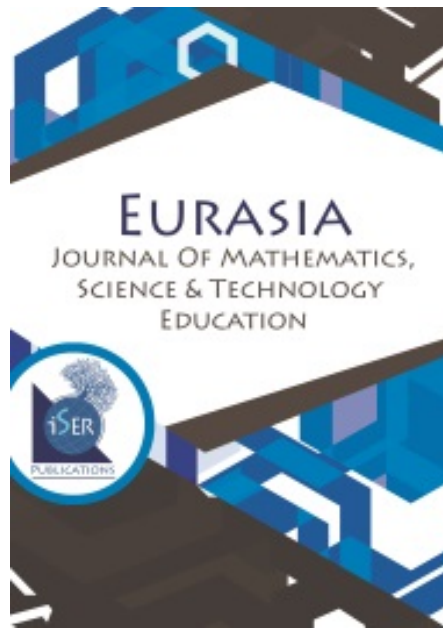
Cover in 2017



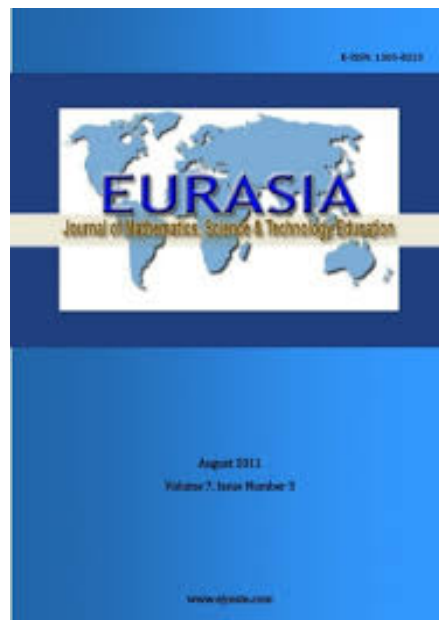
Cover in 2016
